AMENDMENT TO H.R. 704
OFFERED BY MS. LOFGREN

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 3. USE OF VISA NUMBERS FOR FAMILY-SPONSORED**
2 **AND EMPLOYMENT-BASED IMMIGRATION.**

3 (a) **WORLDWIDE LEVEL OF IMMIGRATION.**—Section
4 201 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
5 1151) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (c)(1)—

7 (A) in subparagraph (A)(i), by striking
8 “480,000” and inserting “507,500”; and

9 (B) in subparagraph (B)(ii), by striking
10 “226,000.” and inserting “253,500.”; and

11 (2) in subsection (d)(1)(A), by striking
12 “140,000,” and inserting “167,500.”.

13 (b) **ALLOCATION OF IMMIGRANT VISAS.**—Section
14 203(a) of such Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)) is amended—

15 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “23,400,” and
16 inserting “28,900.”;

17 (2) in paragraph (2)—

18 (A) by striking “114,200,” and inserting
19 “125,200.”; and

1 (B) by striking “226,000,” and inserting
2 “253,500,”;

3 (3) in paragraph (3), by striking “23,400,” and
4 inserting “28,900,”; and

5 (4) in paragraph (4), by striking “65,000,” and
6 inserting “70,500,”.

7 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
8 this section shall take effect on October 1, 2011.
